

**The presentation 4.10 ‘What’s Happening?’ and the improvisation 4.20 ‘Judgement Day’ should have helped the students to form an opinion about tobacco and the Third World. Now it is time for them to express their views.**

**Put the following propositions to the students and invite them to vote for or against—they may abstain. Chart the results where the class can see them. Alternatively, print the chart 4.40 ‘Decision Time Ballot’ onto a transparency and use it on an overhead projector.**

- 1 Cigarette packs should carry health warnings wherever they are sold.
- 2 There should be worldwide control of tobacco advertising and sponsorship.
- 3 Safety standards, such as cigarette tar levels, should be global.
- 4 Promotions such as giving free cigarettes to young people are immoral.
- 5 Tobacco should not be grown in place of food.
- 6 Tobacco companies should not provide loans to new tobacco farmers.
- 7 Rich countries pressing the poor to grow and use tobacco are irresponsible.
- 8 Tobacco companies should subsidise health services in countries they sell to.
- 9 The environmental consequences of producing tobacco are unacceptable.
- 10 The global epidemic of disease and early death from smoking is preventable.
